Alyssa Williams-Schafer is the Coordinator for Sex Offender Services for the Illinois Department of Corrections. She graduated with a Bachelors degree in Psychology from Bradley University and a Masters degree in Psychology from Chapman University.

Her experience with the Illinois Department of Corrections includes the following positions: Sex Offender Therapist with adult parolees, Casework Supervisor with incarcerated juvenile females, Clinical Services Supervisor with incarcerated juvenile females, Warden at Dwight Correctional Center - a maximum security adult female institution, and her current position.

As Coordinator for Sex Offender Services, Ms. Williams-Schafer oversees the following sex offender programs and services: the Sexually Violent Person's Evaluation Unit, the Sexually Dangerous Person's Treatment Program, the Chicago Special Needs Treatment Center, and the East St. Louis Sex Offender treatment program. Ms. Williams-Schafer also coordinates the GPS program, oversees the approval/denial of all sex offender parole placements, serves as licensing administrator for transitional housing in Illinois, conducts training with staff working with sex offenders, works with state and local entities regarding sex offender related legislation, and serves as the Illinois Department of Corrections representative on the State of Illinois Sex Offender Management Board.



In 1995, **Robert Ley** graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Law Enforcement Justice Administration from Western Illinois University in Macomb, Illinois, and he is a 2000 graduate of the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy in Glen Ellyn, Illinois.

Mr. Ley has held several positions in law enforcement and investigations including at the Illinois Department of Revenue, the City of Chicago Inspector General's Office, and the Illinois Department of Corrections.

Mr. Ley is currently a Parole Supervisor with the Parole Division for the Illinois Department of Corrections. Mr. Ley supervises the Sex Offender Supervision Unit for 47 counties in southern Illinois. He also helped develop policies and procedures for the statewide Sex Offender Supervision Unit and often is called upon to be an instructor at the Department's training academy in Springfield, Illinois. He also conducts public speaking throughout the state to government and community groups.

Mr. Ley is a member of the United States Marshals Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force, specializing in apprehending fugitive sex offenders and other violent offenders. As a task force officer, Mr. Ley has also assisted the Major Case Squad of Greater St. Louis in several high profile cases. Mr. Ley is a member of the Fraternal Order of Police and the American Probation and Parole Association.
